




School Rules Uniform Red jumper or cardigan, white polo shit, grey trousers, black shoes (no trainers or boots) Please label your child's clothes with their name-including coats Spare clothes to be left in school in a labelled carrier bag- this will save bringing bags backwards and forwards. In all weathers the children will have access to the outdoor area please ensure they have suitable coats, hats etc. Wellies can be left in school in the space below their pegs. No PE kit is required — Children will have PE in the Nursery (yoga, keep fit, wake up shake up, meditation, outdoor PE, in school PE after Christmas).








Phonics Children will begin to learn their letters after October half term — They will learn a letter a week. We encourage children to bring in an object from home to support that sound which they will share during group time Nursery Parents Eve This will take place w/b 12th November during stay and play sessions. You will be asked to come and join your child for a session. During that session you will have the opportunity to talk to your child's group teacher and discuss their baseline assessment and progress to date.
